



FLEXIm dedicated licenses

Tech Tip:

Using dedicated FLEXIm licenses

FLEXIm can be run in a dedicated fashion by generating a FLEXIm license that is dedicated, then put on that client machine that has Cadra on it. If you are using FLEXIm in this fashion, there is no need to load the FLEXIm Server software from our Cadra CD. You are not accessing the server for the *.lic file. In order to find the hostid you would run lmhostid that is installed in base directory in which you installed Cadra. Do these steps for each machine that you want FLEXIm dedicated license to run on.

Note exception: using FLEXIm in this fashion is not supported on Vista Business platforms.

- Send the name and hosted (output from lmhostid) of each system requiring a license to SofTech. These are the systems where the dedicated licenses are to be used.
- SofTech issue license file(s) (*.LIC) to you.
- Save the >LIC file(s) you receive to a directory on the licensed systems.
- Set the ADRA-NLS statement in the cadra.ini file to point to the full file specification of your nls.txt file.
- Create the nls.txt file. Place the following statement in the nls.txt file.
.globetrotter <path> where <path> is the absolute path to the directory where the *LIC file resides. Do not include a file name in the path. Example: <.globetrotter c:\cadra>
